The invention refers to medicine, namely to balneology and may be used for treatment of gynecological affections. Summary of the invention consists in carrying out vaginal irrigations with sulphureted (H_2S - 49...78 mg/L) and sodium-chloride (NaCl - 69...72 g/L) mineral waters with a high content of iodine (22 mg/L) and bromine (136 mg/L), diluted with water in the ratio of 1:1, at the temperature of $38...40^{\circ}C$, daily, concomitantly with the magnetotherapy with a magnetic induction value of 35 mT applied in the suprapubic and inguinal regions, with the procedure period of 15 min, the cure being of 15 procedures. Then there are taken general baths with mineral waters of the same concentration and period at the temperature of $36^{\circ}C$.
