The invention refers to pharmacology and food industry and may be used for preparation of teas used for curative-prophylactic purpose.

Summary of the invention consists in that the phytotherapeutic composition includes the aboveground part of common marjoram, St. John's wort, milfoil and leuzea carthamoides, liquorice and brandy mint leaves, in the following component ratio, mass % :

Claims: 1
