The invention refers to the pharmacology and food industry and may be used for preparing teas with curative-and-prophylactic properties.

Summary of the invention consists in that the phytotherapeutic composition includes the aboveground part of common marjoram, milfoil, St. John's wort, liquorice, pine buds, sweet calamus rhizomes, elder flowers and brandy mint leaves, in the following component ratio, mass %:

aboveground part of common marjoram	57
aboveground part of milfoil	1618
aboveground part of St. John's wort	1214
liquorice	79
pine buds	68
sweet calamus rhizomes	1921
elder flowers	1315
brandy mint leaves	the rest.
