The invention refers to the production of alcoholic drinks, namely to a composition of liqueur bitters.

The composition, according to the invention, comprises for 1000 dal of blending, in L: hydroalcoholic tinctures of red pepper 80...100, black pepper 25...35, brandy mint 15...20, perennial savory 25...30, Jamaica pepper 30...40, hydroalcoholic solution of bee honey (1:5) 80...100, caramel 5...8, ethyl alcohol and softened water the rest, up to the strength of 40.0 ± 0.2 vol.%.

The result consists in expanding the assortment of natural liqueurs of local raw material with increased organoleptic, nutritive and curative properties.
