The invention relates to the wine industry, namely to staves for use in the production of wine products. The stave, according to the invention, represents a body of oak wood of oblong shape, wherein are made, on a segment of 50...95% of body length, longitudinal parallel through cuts of a width of 2...5 mm, at a distance of 7...20 mm between them, the cuts being made in the thickness and/or width of the body. The result is to increase the specific surface of staves.
