The invention relates to zootechny, in particular to a process for stimulating the growth of fur-producing animals.

The process for stimulating the growth of fur-producing animals includes addition into the animals feed of the culture liquid of streptomycete *S. massaporeus* 36, that is introduced into the feed one time a day during a month from the calculation: in the first ten-day period for 0,8...1,2 ml, in the second ten-day period for 1,3...1,7 ml and in the third ten-day period for 1,8...2,2 ml to a feed portion.

The result of the invention consists in increasing the live mass of the fur-producing animals.
