The invention refers to the alcoholic beverage industry, in particular to a balsam.

The balsam, according to the invention, contains hydroalcoholic macerate of vegetal raw material: aboveground part of common marjoram, St. John's wort and milfoil, sweet flag calamus rhizomes, liquorice root, leuzea carthamoides root and rhizomes, as well as the ingredients: desert red wine with the strength of 16% vol., caramel, citric acid, sugar and hydroalcoholic solution; at the same time the vegetal raw material and the ingredients are taken in the following ratio for 1000 L of finished product, in kg: aboveground part of common marjoram 0,25...0,35, aboveground part of St. John's wort 0,55...0,77, aboveground part of milfoil 0,55...0,74, sweet flag calamus rhizomes 0,050...0,075, liquorice root 0,85...1,15, leuzea carthamoides root and rhizomes 0,51...0,71, caramel 8,5...11,5, citric acid 0,07...0,11, sugar 68,3...89,8, in L: desert red wine with the strength of 16% vol. 221...299, hydroalcoholic solution the rest, up to the strength of 42,0±0,5% vol.
