The invention refers to medicine, namely to surgery and may be used for laparoscopic surgery in gynecology to previously operated patients with longitudinal cicatrice placed in the Hunter's line.

The method of conducting laparoscopic gynecological operations after midline lower laparotomy consists in that it is made a buttonhole in the point of intersection of the umbilical ring inferior boundary with the median line of abdomen. Then it is introduced through it into the abdominal cavity perpendicular to the abdominal wall a trocar, it is drawn out therefrom the mandrin and it is introduced a laparoscope, it is produced the pneumoperitoneum. Under visual control there are made buttonholes into two symmetrical points, placed 2 cm above the pubic symphysis and 8 cm laterally from the median line of abdomen, there are introduced through them two trocars for appliances and radiomanipulating instruments, there are excised the adhesions, necessarily, there are carried out the required surgical manipulations, there are removed the appliances and there are sutured the buttonholes.
