The invention refers to the pharmacology and food industry and may be used for preparing teas with curative-and-prophylactic properties.

Summary of the invention consists in that the phytotherapeutic composition includes the aboveground part of common marjoram, St. John's wort, milfoil and lemon balm, sweet calamus rhizomes, pine buds and wild rose hips, in the following component ratio, mass %:

aboveground part of common marjoram	12...15
aboveground part of St. John's wort	12...15
aboveground part of milfoil	15...17
aboveground part of lemon balm	11...12
sweet calamus rhizomes	14...18
pine buds	10...12
wild rose hips	the rest.
